Resumption of Seven Stars in Kyushu services

Services of the Seven Stars in Kyushu have been suspended since March 2020.

Kyushu Railway Company plans to resume services of the Seven Stars from the July 14th 2020 run. For the immediate future, measures will be implemented to prevent the spread of Covid-19, with hopes that our guests can participate in a tour with a peace of mind.

- Resumption of services

1. 4 Days 3 Nights journey: July 14th 2020 (Tue-Fri)
2. 2 Days 1 Night journey: July 18th 2020 (Sat-Sun)

*July 7th-10th 2020 will be a 4D3N training journey in preparation for the 14th run.

*A special tour in association with Lexus (Lexus Crafted Journey) was planned for July 18, but this tour has been rescheduled for a later date. The July 18-19 run will be a regular Seven Stars in Kyushu journey instead.

*August 8th-14th is a scheduled suspension of services. Please check the official homepage for the latest updates on the operating schedule.

*Please note that the operating schedule is subject to change.

- Measures to prevent the spread of Covid-19

- Guest numbers will be limited to a maximum of 16 (8 couples), and measures for social distancing will be implemented.

- Measures will be taken to monitor the health of guests with thermometers.

Please note that guests may be asked to refrain from boarding if they have a fever.

- Further improvements will be implemented in the cleaning and sterilization methods of the public spaces and guest rooms.
- Alcohol-based hand sanitizer units will be increased.
- Staff are to wear masks, monitor their health, and take measures to ensure hygiene standards are met.

We will implement appropriate measures to prevent the spread of Covid-19, and continue to place priority on safety first.
